Contact lenses are FDA regulated medical device used to correct vision. It serves as an alternative to glasses or refractive surgery. However unlike a pair of glasses correction, because a contact lens touches the cornea, the inside of the lids and conjunctiva, contact lens wear can pose a threat to the health of these tissues, causing discomfort and pain, and even permanent vision loss if not fitted properly by a licensed professional and cared for meticulously by a well-informed wearer.
